Responsibilities:

- Develop and coordinate worship services
- Lead in the annual Advent Vesper Service
- Oversee proper maintenance and regular tuning of the organ and pianos
- Select music and direct adult choirs; worship and bell
- Recruit members for the worship choir, fostering a community atmosphere keeping informed the members of on-going schedules of practice and performances
- Recruit members for music opportunities
- Invite regularly outside musicians for special music
- Meet with Pastor weekly
- Meet with Worship and Music Team at least quarterly
- Participate in the life of the congregation
